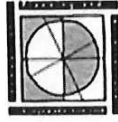

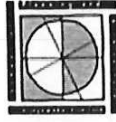

General Instructions for Fee Payment

- I. All Students are required to pay the fees through SB-Collect (online) only. The payment procedure is to be followed as instructions available in the SPAV website.
- II. The Fees for PhD and PG Direct Admissions need to be paid before the deadline as indicated by SPA Vijayawada in the admission notifications, to confirm the seats.
- III. The Fees for B.Arch and B.Plan and M.Arch and M.Plan and other PG courses need to be paid before the deadline as indicated by JoSAA/CSAB and CCMT in their admission notifications, to confirm the seats.
- IV. Fees paid at JoSAA/DASA (excluding Registration Fees) will be adjusted against the Institute Fees payable in the 1st Semester. The balance of the Institute Fees need to be paid over and above the JoSAA/DASA/CCMT fees to confirm the seats.**
- V. Students who have applied education loan (Bank) for payment of fees, have to submit a certificate issued by the concerned banker to Accounts Department wherein the details of - Name of the student, Registration No., Course, Year, UTR No. (Bank Remittance Particulars) and date of remittance etc., need to be mentioned.
- VI. Repeaters, if any, at any of the year of studies, have to pay the fees applicable to the concerned year that is getting repeated again.

The following information was obtained from the records of the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Assistant Secretary for Health, regarding the activities of the National Health and Medical Research Council (NH&MRC) during the period from 1970 to 1972.

The NH&MRC is a statutory body established under the Health Research Act 1960. Its primary function is to advise the Government on matters relating to health research and to coordinate and promote health research in Australia.

During the period from 1970 to 1972, the NH&MRC was engaged in a number of activities, including the following:

- 1. The NH&MRC conducted a number of research projects in the field of health and medicine, including research into the causes and prevention of heart disease, cancer, and mental illness.
- 2. The NH&MRC was involved in the development and implementation of a number of health research programs, including the National Heart Research Program, the National Cancer Research Program, and the National Mental Health Research Program.
- 3. The NH&MRC was also engaged in a number of public health and health promotion activities, including the development of health education materials and the implementation of health promotion campaigns.
