This year, it being the culmination of the 150th Birth Anniversary of the Bhagwan Birsa Munda on 15.11.2025, Ministry of Tribal Affairs has decided to celebrate the 5th Janjatiya Gaurav Divas 2025 as a commemorative event in the central and every states/UTs during the period commencing from 1st November, 2025 and culminating on 15th November, 2025. Celebration of the main commemorative event at the national level would be led by the Ministry of Culture and the Hon'ble Prime Minister is. General Instructions:

- Need to organize JJGD in a meaningful manner, with active participation of all concerned stakeholders
- ii. Participation should be very wide, and messaging should be an important part of this celebration. The celebration should not be an end in itself but should lead to active participation in meaningful and creative activities related to improvement in education, health and livelihood aspects. Preservation and promotion of tribal culture would also be a significant part of the celebrations.
- iii. A calendar of activities for the period from 1.11.2025 to 15.11.2025 and from may be got prepared and shared with this Ministry by 10.11.2025.

Illustrative list of Activities for the JJGD:

- a. Floral tributes in the educational institutions and hostels of residential institutions to Bhagwan Birsa Munda and other tribal freedom fighters on 15.11.2025
- Installing selfie points (as shared by the MoTA on its portal/website) for the students and faculty to take selfies
- Organization of age-appropriate training/workshops on tribal art, dance, music, crafts, culture, contributions to Indian society, especially in the freedom struggle and protection of environment
- d. Honouring of tribal achievers, including outstanding tribal scholars, who can serve as role models for the students
- Outreach activities to the tribal communities by students such as involving in Swatchata activities, plantation initiatives, each one teach one, enrolment in NSS/NCC/MyBharat
- Cultural events such as dance, drama, music, painting and other arts and crafts associated with tribal communities.
- Quizzes on tribal freedom fighters, tribal culture and heritage, tribal crafts etc may be held
- h. Competitions
 - i. Painting
 - ii. story writing
 - iii. poetry
 - iv. dance.
 - v. music,

- vi. drama,
- vii. nukkad nataks,
- viii. skits,
- short-write ups (250-500 words on the topic know my tribe/ Tribal Freedom Fighters, Tribal Achievers, Tribal Languages etc.) and
- x. any other field as well as quizzes may be held on various aspects of tribal matters
- xi. Learning of Tribal Languages and Tribals ways of life.
- xii. Capacity building of faculty may also be taken up. Training of Trainers & others may also be taken up.
- Where the institution is a hostel or a residential one, at least one item in at least one of the daily meals during this period may be a tribal recipe, so as to introduce the students to the culinary heritage.
- Encouragement to POSHAN vatikas in the institutions, as well as plantation activities, including the adoption of a tree by each student.
