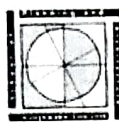

Proceedings	<p>During the syllabus revision process prior to the 17th Senate meeting, the subject categories were inadvertently omitted from the course structure. This oversight has now been rectified, and the revised syllabus clearly specifies the category for each subject, i.e., Studio Courses, Theory Courses, and Jury Courses. In the earlier version, all subjects were mistakenly categorized as Theory Courses.</p> <p>The revised Course Structure for the M.Arch (Architectural Conservation) Programme is placed for consideration and approval of the Senate.</p>
Decision	The Senate approved the addition of subject categories to the approved detailed syllabus of the M.Arch (AC) programme
Item # 21.5	To consider and approve the request of students with respect to the working hours of the institute in view of the increasing temperatures during summer.
Proceedings	It has been observed in the past few years that the temperatures during summers increase beyond 40° in the afternoons. The students find it difficult to work in the afternoons in the studios during summer months.


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	<p>Representation from the student council has been received, requesting for change in working hours during summer months considering the heat. Based on the representation, the departments have proposed to modify the working hour schedule as placed in annexure IV which is recommended by the ABoS of both the departments.</p> <p>The proposed change in working hours for students without deviating from the number of periods / hours per day as stipulated in the course structure, is placed for consideration and approval of the senate.</p>
Decision	<p>After detailed deliberations, the Senate approved the modified working hour schedule for implementation from Mid-March to till the end of even semester classes in April on experimental basis. Any suitable modifications to the above working hours schedule may be made at the discretion of the Director based on practical issues.</p>

Item # 21.6	To consider and approve the Elective IV - Entrepreneurship Skills for Architects (ARC5124) course offered to B.Arch V Year programme to jury based course from theory based course
Proceedings	<p>The Elective IV - Entrepreneurship Skills for Architects (ARC5124) offered to B.Arch V Year students was conceived initially as a theory subject and the same was approved in the 6th meeting of the Senate. However, when the above Elective was offered to the students for the first time in the A.Y.2024-25, the subject experts and the ABoS of the Department of Architecture felt that the course be offered as a Jury course that allows students to articulate their ideas, defend their prototypes, and engage in meaningful discussions about the future potential of their projects. In view of the above, the ABoS of the Department of Architecture, proposed that the course be changed to Jury course from theory course. Based on the above, the proposal for modifying the Elective IV - Entrepreneurship Skills for Architects (ARC5124) course from theory-based course to jury based</p>

	<p>course was approved by the Chairperson, Senate and the End semester examination for the Elective IV - Entrepreneurship Skills for Architects course was conducted as a Jury course during December 2024.</p> <p>The above item is placed before the Senate for Ratification.</p>
Decision	The Senate ratified the Elective IV - Entrepreneurship Skills for Architects (ARC5124) course to be offered as a jury course.

Item # 21.7	To consider offering of AI based courses for urban planning at SPAV
Proceedings	Dr.S.P.Sekar (ITPI nominee) stressed the importance of AI based urban planning and offering skill based professional courses at SPAV. Such courses can be introduced as an elective initially, and later it can offered as a mainstream course / certificate course / online course.
